

Minnesota Property Tax Refund

Minnesota has two property tax refund programs that may be for you!

- **Regular property tax refund**

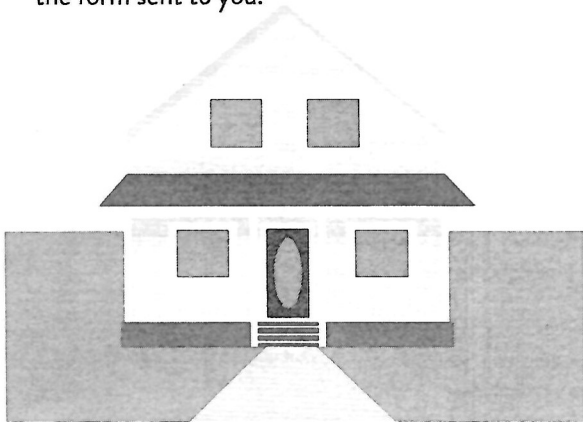
This refund is available for **homeowners and renters with either a Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)**. Visit www.revenue.state.mn.us to see if you qualify!

- **Special property tax refund (for homeowners)**

If you are a homeowner, you may qualify if your property taxes this year were at least 12% (6% for 2022) higher than last year and you owned and lived in your home on January 2 of each year. The increase must be at least \$100. There is no income limit.

Ready to apply?

- Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us to file electronically or download Form M1PR, *Homestead Credit Refund (for Homeowners) and Renter's Property Tax Refund*.
- Call 651-296-3781 or 1-800-652-9094 to have the form sent to you.

Looking for the status of your property tax refund?

Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us after July 1 and choose **Where's My Refund?** under **Top Tasks** to monitor the status of your refund. With our **Where's my Refund?** system, you can:

- See if we've received your return
- Follow your return through the process
- Understand the steps your return goes through before a refund is sent
- See the actual date your refund was sent

When you use **Where's My Refund?**, we ask for the exact amount of your refund in addition to your date of birth and Social Security Number (or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number).

Don't have a computer? You can call our automated phone line at 651-296-4444 or 1-800-657-3676 to get the status of your refund.

What can I do to get my refund faster?

- Electronically file your return by the due date
- Choose direct deposit (use an account you do not plan on closing; bank accounts cannot be changed on returns)
- Include all documentation

Each return is different and we process them as quickly as we can, making sure the right refund goes to the right person.
